

Should you reflect on your Daily Scrum? CHECKLIST

From time to time it is worthwhile to reflect on a Scrum Event in a Sprint Retrospective. This list will help you to assess if it is time for your Daily Scrum. Tick the appropriate box, if it is true. If more than 6 questions are open, it is worthwhile.

Our Daily Scrum...

- 1.) ... takes place daily
- 2.) ... always takes place at the same time
- 3.) ... is always at the same place
- 4.) ... is a real exchange for the developers
- 5.) ... uses the timebox of 15 minutes
- 6.) ... includes active participation of all developers
- 7.) ... takes place on time
- 8.) ... gives us the space to talk about progress towards the sprint goal
- 9.) ... is the coordination of an action plan for the day
- 10.) ... all developers participate
- 11.) ... is designed according to the team needs
- 12.) ... uses a Sprint Backlog
- 13.) ... is prepared: everyone knows what they are working on
- 14.) ... Developers actively work with the Sprint Backlog themselves
- 15.) ... addresses impediments
- 16.) ... does not slip into details
- 17.) ... is not a status meeting
- 18.) ... we do not find boring
- 19.) ... makes clear to everyone who is working on what
- 20.) ... doesn't mindlessly pray down three questions
